### OUR SCHOOL

Our school is located in the beautiful village of North Kilworth. It looks over open green spaces and has ample space for the children to run and play. We offer Forest School sessions and lots of outdoor learning opportunities.

Our light and airy classrooms provide a calm space for teaching and learning, while our purpose built EYFS setting offers our younger children their own space to feel safe and happy as they grow and develop.

### PRESCHOOL

St Andrew's Preschool is located within our Early Years setting and provides the perfect chance for younger children to experience the very best start to school life. For age 3+ children with funded places available. Contact the school Office for details and to book a tour.



### COMMUNITY

The school is supported really well by its local community. Our PTA organise a variety of events in order to raise funds for the school, our governors volunteer to support the children in their continued development; and our strong link with St Andrew's Church means we take part in services and events regularly, also acting as a collection point for their Food Bank donations.



### HOT SCHOOL MEALS

School meals are provided by our caterers Miquil and are cooked fresh and delivered daily. Children can choose from hot or cold options via the seasonal menu. Children are also welcome to bring a packed lunch if they prefer. (Water and a healthy snack from home are also permitted.)

Free school meals are offered to all children in Foundation Stage and Years 1 and 2 under the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meals programme, and any child entitled to Pupil Premium will also receive a free school lunch.

### WIDER CURRICULUM OPPORTUNITIES

We provide lunch time and after school clubs for a variety of sports, including netball, football, multi skills, cross country, hockey and gymnastics.

Children in KS2 have the opportunity to learn to play a variety of musical instruments. We also have a variety of school leadership roles available to the children, including Sports Captains, Team Captains, Wellbeing Ambassadors and School Council members.

We provide enrichment opportunities throughout the year, meaning the children receive visits from authors and interesting speakers, they travel to local events linked to their learning, explore museums and galleries and they enjoy visiting the theatre. We also offer a residential for our children in Year 6 which comprises of over night stays and lots of outdoor activities!
